Our Mobile Food Pantry Program provides a supply of supplemental nutritious food to those who meet our income qualifications or are in crisis. We offer a safe and convenient drive-through service at all of our Mobile Food Pantry Program locations.

Type of Food Available

Our availability varies but you may receive shelfstable, fresh or frozen protein, grains, fruits, vegetables, and dairy. Items like cereal, pasta, brown or white rice; protein like beef, chicken, tuna, or peanut butter; dairy like milk or cheese; fruits, vegetables and more.

What is required?

You'll just need to provide the number of people in your household and your household income (no proof is required).

Am I qualified?

We use the Federal Poverty Guidelines to determine income eligibility for our programs. You also qualify if you participate in any of the programs listed below. If you are in crisis (experienced a fire, flood, medical emergency, etc.) you may also access our program.
